LEVEL 0	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Indoor socialising: 8 people, 3 households Outdoor socialising: 15 people, 5 households No non-essential travel to Level 3/4 areas Schools, colleges and universities are open Avoid car sharing with people outside household Workplaces are open, but homeworking remains the default option wherever possible
LEVEL 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Indoor socialising: 6 people, 2 households Outdoor socialising: 6 people, 2 households No non-essential travel to Level 3/4 areas Schools, colleges and universities are open Avoid car sharing with people outside household Workplaces are open, but homeworking remains the default option wherever possible
LEVEL 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Indoor socialising is not permitted Outdoor socialising: 6 people, 2 households No non-essential travel to Level 3/4 areas Schools are open with enhanced protective measures Colleges and universities are open Avoid car sharing with people outside household Workplaces are open, but homeworking remains the default option wherever possible
LEVEL 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Indoor socialising is not permitted Outdoor socialising: 6 people, 2 households No non-essential travel into or out of the Level 3 area Schools are open with enhanced protective measures Colleges and universities are open with restricted blended learning models in place Avoid public transport and car sharing with people outside household wherever possible Workplaces are open, but homeworking remains the default option wherever possible
LEVEL 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Indoor socialising is not permitted Outdoor socialising: 6 people, 2 households No non-essential travel into or out of the Level 4 area Schools are open with enhanced and targeted measures in place Colleges and universities are open with restricted blended learning models in place Avoid public transport and car sharing with people outside household wherever possible Only essential indoor workplaces are open, along with outdoor workplaces in certain sectors

The Scottish Government's five-tier Strategic Framework aims to suppress Coronavirus across the country with local targeted measures.

Level 0 represents the closest we can get to normality without a vaccine, whilst Level 4 measures are close to a return to a full lockdown.
