This privacy statement relates to processing of personal data of members of the Board of Management.

Information will be used for the following purposes:

Processing applications and interviews; communication; highlighting Board activities (website); registering of interests; monitoring equality and diversity in Board membership.

Our lawful basis for using the data is that use is necessary for the performing a task in the public interest or under official authority vested in us.

The data being used includes special category (sensitive) data. We use this sensitive data under the following lawful basis: use is necessary for reasons of substantial public interest: Data Protection Act 2018, Schedule 1, 6.(2)(a) – conferred by an enactment or rule of law (Equality Act 2010)

If you were to withhold the personal information we require for this process, the consequences would be that you would be unable to become a board member. For special category data, there would be no consequences, as this is an optional process.

Your data will, or may, be shared with the following recipients or categories of recipient:

Training related data will be shared with College Development Network.
Gender data will be shared with Colleges Scotland.
Your photo, bio information and register of interests will be published on the College website, and therefore in the public domain.
Scottish Government, Companies House and external auditors for statutory reasons.

Your data will be retained for the following length of time:

Length of your board membership, plus six years.

The following rights are rights of data subjects:

- The right to access your personal data
- The right to rectification if the personal data we hold about you is incorrect
- The right to restrict processing of your personal data

The following rights apply only in certain circumstances:

- The right to withdraw consent at any time if consent is our lawful basis for processing your data
- The right to object to our processing of your personal data
- The right to request erasure (deletion) of your personal data
- The right to data portability
